Please read carefully and keep this information for further reference.

Thank you for buying a Crosswater Product. To ensure that it works to its full potential, it needs to be fitted correctly. Check the contents of the pack carefully before installation.

Bathroom Brands will not be held responsible for any de-fit/ re-fit costs where faulty product has been fitted. If any fault is found with materials or workmanship, it must be reported immediately to the manufacturer. Remedial action will be taken, based on information received, on condition that:

1. Full details are supplied to the manufacturer.

2. The product has not been modified or tampered with;

3. The manufacturer is informed of any damage/shortages prior to installation.

4. The product has not been installed, or attempts have been made to install.

We do not accept responsibility for any problems that may occur through incorrect installation. This product should only be installed by a suitably qualified plumber/installer.


Should the installation be completed by a non-qualified person any product guarantee maybe considered invalid. For a claim made under our warranty, written certification of your installer's qualifications may be required.

Important Pre-Installation Notes


Check tray before beginning installation process. Check the tray tolerance before beginning the installation process, as below. Tolerance is measured on the top of the tray ONLY. Any variances on the base of the tray will be taken up by following the correct installation process.



1. Place the tray on a flat level surface, larger than the tray.



2. Use a long spirit level placed on the edge of the tray.



3. Measure the gap between the spirit level and top of the tray. Do not push the spirit level down at the opposite end, this will give an incorrect measurement.



4. Repeat on all edges.

BEFORE INSTALLATION:

Ensure the intended shower enclosure dimensions are compatible with the shower tray, taking into account the reduction in tray dimension that will result after tiles/wall panelling have been fitted.

Ensure the space available is correct for the shower tray purchased.

Tile or install wall coverings before fitting the tray. We recommend fitting wall covering down onto the tray.

Avoid positioning any high pressure water feeds directly over the waste, this may compromise waste capacity. Check the flow rate of intended power/deluge shower fittings does not exceed the flow rate capacity of the shower waste capacity.

It is the installers responsibility to ensure the shower suite has been arranged to retain water as per the needs of the customer.

The shower tray purchased is designed to be fitted directly to a wooden (Marine plywood and not floor boards) or concrete floor. Therefore, the plumbing services MUST BE fitted below the floor surface. If this is not possible a tray riser kit may be purchased as an additional item which comes complete with a leg set.

THIS TRAY MUST BE INSTALLED USING CROSSWATER SHOWER WASTE VTHFWS90.

The manufacturing tolerance for each CREO tray size can be found at www.crosswater.co.uk. Please check the measurements taken from the purchased tray ONLY with the published tolerances.









































4b USE EITHER METHOD 4a_OR 4b (MORTAR BOARD BASE)




Mix sand and cement at 5:1 ratio and combine an anti-crumbling additive. Spread evenly over the entire area under the tray with approximately 10-15mm thick mixed mortar screed.


Any unsupported sections under the tray could lead to cracking.

Allow to dry for at least 24 Hours.













IMPORTANT: ALWAYS USE 8 RISER LEGS

1. Before bonding the feet to the shower tray, identify the foot bonding locations underneath the shower tray according to this instruction.

2. Before installing the shower tray, use the degreasing wipes included to wipe clean the areas on the shower tray where the feet will be bonded, and each foot top that will pair with the shower tray. Apply the 3M VHB double-sided adhesive tape to the foot tops only when the surfaces are degreased and cleaned with the degreasing wipes.

3. Bond the feet in the centres of the bosses located underneath the shower tray. In some shower tray models, the boss surfaces may be smaller than the foot top face. This does not affect the quality of bonding.

4. Keep the work place clean and dry during bonding. If the surfaces cleaned with the degreasing wipes become dirty or polluted with dust before bonding, repeat the cleaning with the wipes. The paired surfaces will only bond securely and durably if properly cleaned and degreased with the wipes.


5. Once the feet have been bonded underneath the shower tray, stand the shower tray on its feet and leave it for 30 minutes for the adhesive tape to develop a grip before proceeding with the installation process.

6. Once the feet have been bonded underneath the shower tray, do not tilt the shower tray so that it rests or becomes loaded on or to its sides; the load must act on the bonded feet along their height only.


7. Do not slide the shower tray with its feet bonded underneath along a longer distance. Li and carry the shower tray when relocating it. You may only slide the shower tray on its feet for a short distance when moving it against the wall.

8. This instruction is provided for the installation of the shower tray on its dedicated feet and on a hard floor (lined with tiles, concrete screed, etc.). There are many factors affecting the proper performance of this product, including different installation materials, substrates, the work environment, etc. Due to this, no perfect application efficiency can be guaranteed for all possible installation and operating conditions. The factors are known to the installer only, and within their reasonable control. The installer shall be solely liable for the proper installation of this product. Any damage or loss which may result during the installation or operation of this product due to non-compliance with the guidelines specified herein are not covered by the product warranty.























































Important Pre-Installation Notes


Please note the following when cutting shower trays:

- 1. Wear gloves and protective glasses while cutting a shower tray.
- 2. Cut the shower tray using diamond blades intended for cutting concrete.
- 3. Do not use a drill in hammer/impact mode to drill holes in the shower tray.
- 4. After cutting, the shower tray must be installed on the floor using assembly adhesive only. Spread the adhesive over the entire surface of the product in accordance with the installation manual. Do not install the cut shower tray on legs.
- 5. The manufacturer does not bear any liability for damage caused as result of cutting the product.























CARE & MAINTENANCE

The surface of all our products is among the highest quality surfaces available, made of Mineral Composite. With normal use, the surface will retain its beauty with only a minimal amount of care.

ABOUT THE MINERAL COMPOSITE

Every Mineral Composite product has a minimum dolomite content of 75%. It's external surface is covered with Nanocoat. The material fully utilises the properties of dolomite stone, while being reinforced with a flexible resin binder to ensure resistance under load, damage from impact and the effects of high and low temperatures.

Products made from Mineral Composite maintain an optimal temperature for a long time. They are always warm to the touch and provide unprecedented comfort in the bathroom.

Due to the inherent strength of the Nanocoat surface products are always pleasant to the touch and have a smooth finish. Mineral Composites insusceptibility to bacterial growth, absorption of water and chemical substances, ensure a long lasting quality and ease of care.

For standard cleaning, gloss and matt finishes, we recommend using widely available non-abrasive cleaning products. The matt finish may occasionally require a mildly abrasive product.

NOTE

To maintain the beauty of the product's surface and avoid unwanted stains from hair dye, cosmetics and other strong coloured products we strongly recommend the immediate removal.

The temperature of the water should never exceed 75°C for a bath or/and shower tray. Avoid any cleaning products that contain natural or artificial dyes, test product on an inconspicuous area before using. Improper use may damage products and invalidate the warranty.

RECOMMENDED FOR GLOSS FINISHES

- 1. For regular cleaning use of universal cleaning agents with non-abrasive properties, or any mild dish soap and water or product specifically made for gloss surfaces.
- 2. After each use rinse the tray with water and dry with a cotton cloth. This will assist build up of limescale and soap residue.
- 3. In order to maintain the product aesthetics we recommend using natural polishing wax, for example, based on beeswax, once per month.
- 4. Stubborn stains, grease, mildew, cosmetic residue must be treated with warm water and gentle non-abrasive cleaning agents or a soap solution with water.
- 5. Never use any abrasive cleaners, or products containing bleach.
- 6. Small scratches can be removed by using Crosswater polishing paste see below.
- 7. Scratches on the surface may be treated with abrasive paper soaked in water. First try a 1500 grit paper, then if needed try a 3000 grit paper. Afterwards, the surface may be polished with a fine grained polishing paste (for painted surface).
- 8. Limescale may be treated with a solution of water and vinegar

SCRATCHED OR DAMAGED SURFACES
